

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND BREEDING AGREEMENT

(1) FEES: Natural service to **226 Favory Naussica** Service Fee: \$A 1,400.00, including GST. This includes a \$300.00 Booking/Handling fee. Under no circumstances will a mare be permitted to leave the Stud until ALL outstanding fees, costs and charges have been paid.

(2) BOOKING: Please make your booking on the form provided overleaf, and forward it via email: the.fulmer.rise.stud@me.com with payment made directly into our bank account BSB 802185. Account 107613. Name Georgina Beard. OR by mail to The Manager, The Fulmer Rise Stud at Walkers Farm, The Pocket, via Billinudgel, NSW 2483, with the Booking/Handling Fee. Cheques to be made out to Georgina Beard.

(3) SERVICE FEE: The service fee is payable on a positive 42 day pregnancy test, **or** when the mare leaves the stud farm. We offer a 'No Foal, Free Return': If the mare slips, or if the foal does not survive 36 hours (Vet Certificate required), the mare may be returned for service the same or following season. However, the handling fee is payable again. In the case of use of the 'Free Return' clause, all associated Veterinary, medical, keep and agistment costs are payable by the owner. If a mare is removed from the Stud prior to the 42 day test a Veterinary Certificate must be forwarded to the Stud within 48 days of the last service proving positive or negative test.

(4) AGISTMENT: All costs and fees must be paid in full before a mare leaves the Stud. See agistment contract. Please sign and return.

(5) MARES:

a) Your mare **MUST** be handled to lead and be tractable in a crush.

(b) We wish to assist you in producing a foal with top class performance potential. Mares with poor conformation or known hereditary diseases or bad performances should not be bred. The Stud reserves the right to refuse service to a mare at any time.

(6) VETERINARY ATTENTION:

(a) All veterinary expenses will be charged direct to the mare's owner/s.

(b) All mares may undergo a veterinary examination prior to breeding. If a major expense has to be incurred, the owner of the mare will be notified beforehand to verify such an expense. However there will be no notification for routine veterinary care.

(c) If the mare is deemed unsuitable for breeding, a substitute mare may be sent.

(d) It is highly recommended that your mare's teeth are attended by an Equine Dentist prior to service.

(7) FARRIER WORK: Please make sure your mare is not wearing shoes when she arrives at the Stud farm. We will arrange with our farrier to have her feet kept trimmed at your expense while she is at the Fulmer Rise Stud.

(8) LIABILITY: All reasonable care will be taken but no responsibility will be accepted for any illness or injury to a mare while she is at Stud. Should the stallion 226 Favory Naussica no longer be available, the stud fee *only* will be refunded.

(9) All transport costs are at the expense of the mare's owner.

(10) The Stud Season runs from August 1. Mares may be bred after mid September.

(11) Artificial insemination using chilled or frozen semen, requires a different fee structure and contract.

(12) You will be issued with a Service Certificate. Your foal may be registered with the Lipizzaner Association of Australasia. We recommend that you join the organization if you are not already a member, as in the case of pure bred Lipizzaner mares, you will need a 'Mare Return' form which must be sent in annually, even in the years your mare is not bred. See www.lipizzaneraustralia.org. The forms you require are downloadable from that site.
